ORDER

WHEREAS information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbance of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area mentioned in the schedule below (of the Shibpur Police Station) in the town of Howrah (hereinafter referred to as the said areas)

And

WHEREAS I Gaurav Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Howrah being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department Order No.-3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.11 to act under the Section 144 of the said Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974)

And

WHEREAS in my opinion, there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

And

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act. 2

of 1974) read with the sub-section (3) of the said section, I, Gaurav Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, do hereby prohibit for the period of 60 (sixty) days from the 4th August, 2019 to 2nd October, 2019 until further orders, any assembly of 05 (five) or more persons in procession or the carrying of any lathi or other dangerous weapons or the doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances to the public tranquility and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

The Schedule

The area within the jurisdiction of Shibpur Police Station in the town of Howrah bounded –

- 1) On the North by - Haradeb Bhattacharyay Road upto and including Mandirtala Bus Stand.
- 2) On the East by - Khetro Banerjee Road, Nabin Banerjee Lane, A K Roy Chowdhury Lane and Mollapara Lane upto G T Road crossing including Kazipara Morh.
Hiralal Banerjee Road, Dinu Master Lane, Mollahpara Lane, Danesh Mollah Lane upto G T Road crossing.
- 3) On the West by - K M Banerjee Road, Circular 2nd Bye Lane, Seikhpara, Kona Expressway upto Carry Road crossing.
K M Banerjee Lane, Sarat Chatterjee Road upto old 58 Bus stand.
- 4) On the South by - Tarapada Chatterjee Road upto and including Betaitala Morh.
- 5) All the ramps of Vidyasagar Setu on Howrah side.

Explanation - In this order, the Town of Howrah means the town of Howrah as defined in Section 2(15) and Schedule - I of the Howrah Municipal Corporation Act, 1980 (Act of 29 of 1980).

ORDER

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places, network service providers and shops have come up in the Metropolitan area of Howrah as notified in this behalf, in the popular name Cyber Cafe,

AND WHEREAS, a large number of people frequently visit these Cafes to use the internet, computer network facilities available in those cyber cafes,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood that the said facilities might be used by persons knowingly or intentionally to mislead the security and investigating agencies, commit offence as defined in Chapter-XI of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), create panic in the public, help in anti-national activities affecting security of the state,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (l) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973(2 of 1974), I, Gaurav Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order, the owners of the said cyber cafes and persons having management of those cyber cafes to follow the followings in respect of those cyber cafes, viz. :-

- a) Prohibiting the use of cyber cafe by unknown person and whose identity has not been established before the owner of the cafe.
- b) Maintaining a register for identity of the visitors or users.
- c) Make an entry in the handwriting of the visitors or users maintaining name, address, telephone number and identity proof. The visitors/users shall also sign the register kept for this purpose
- d) The identity of the visitors or users shall be established through Identity Card, Voter Card, Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and Photo Credit Card (any one of them).
- e) Activity server log should be preserved in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months from the point of last use.
- f) If any activity of any visitors or users is of a suspicious nature, the owner of Cyber Cafe shall immediately inform the nearest Police Station.
- g) Record be maintained about the specific computer used by the visitor or user.

This order shall come into force on and from **9th day of August, 2019** and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto **7th day of October, 2019** unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order, is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through press and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of all Divisional D.Cs.P, A.D.C.Ps, A.Cs.P and all Police Stations concerned;

ORDER

WHEREAS, from the reports received so far, there is sufficient ground to apprehend that the terrorists or anti-social elements may seek hideouts in the residential areas of the Police Stations, falling under metropolitan area of Howrah,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property on that account,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt necessary that some procedural safeguards should be put on tenancy or licensing process prevailing, so that terrorists or anti-social elements in the guise of tenants may not get tenancy or license for residential purpose and to cause disturbance or public tranquility or danger to human life or safety to public at large,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (l) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), I, Gaurav Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order that no land-lord or owner or person whose property falls under the jurisdiction of area of any of the Police Stations under Howrah Metropolitan area shall let/sublet/lease/rent out any residential accommodation or grant lease or license to any person unless and until the said landlord/owner/person has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s)/ license as the case may be as per the Proforma in Schedule-I to the Officer -in-Charge of the Police Station concerned. And whoever having property in his possession or under his management shall also inform in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premise falls about the particulars of the tenants or leasee or licensee as the case may be as per the said proforma.

This order shall come into force on and from **9th day of August, 2019** and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto **7th day of October, 2019** unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through Howrah Police Gazette, Official Website of Howrah City Police and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of DCP, Zone-I (North Division), DCP, Zone-II (South Division), ADCP (South Division), Divisional ACPs and all Police Stations concerned and the Offices of Howrah Municipal Corporation.

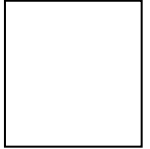

ORDER

Whereas it is necessary for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with the ID-UZ-ZOHA (Bakr-Id) festival on 12.08.19, I, Gaurav Sharma, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah, in exercise of power conferred upon me u/s 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2002 of Transport Department, do hereby issue the following restrictive orders in the following manner prescribed below –

I. Restriction on movement of Goods Vehicles towards Kolkata and also within the Howrah Commissionerate area from 04:00 hrs. to 12:00 hrs. on 12.08.19 shall be as follows –

1. Nimtola crossing towards Bally along GT Road.
2. Ballykhal Island towards Bally along GT Road.
3. Bamundanga Island towards GT Road & Vivekananda Setu.
4. Nibedita Setu Northern Flank (Maitypara Crossing) towards Dakshineswar & Dunlop via Nibedita Setu.
5. Near Salap More towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road.
6. Near Salap Bazar towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road.
7. Kona More on NH6 towards Liluah along Benaras Road.
8. Kona More on NH6 towards Jagadishpur along Benaras Road.
9. Kazipara crossing towards Kolkata via 2nd Hooghly Bridge & towards Howrah via GT Road.
10. Coal Depot towards Howrah along Foreshore Road.
11. Toll plaza towards, Kolkata 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
12. Near Alampur More towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
13. Hansung crossing towards Drainage Canal Road & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
14. Kona Truck terminal towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Express Way & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
15. Near Nibra More towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Express Way & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
16. Near IOC petrol pump at Jagadishpur on Benaras Road towards Kona Crossing along Eksara..

II. Diversion on movement of all classes of vehicles within the Howrah Commissionerate area from 06:00 hrs. to 12:00 hrs. on 12.08.19 shall be as follows -

1. From Sanpur crossing on Drainage Canal Road towards Bantra PS along Makardaha Road.
2. Howrah Amta Road & CTI crossing near Dasnagar I/C towards Bankra.
3. Salop Kaborpara towards Bankra on Howrah Amta Road.
4. From Garfa crossing along Kona Expressway up-to Sundarpara through Southern flank.
5. At Chatterjeepara crossing towards East West Bypass.
6. East West Bypass & Belilious Road X-ing towards Chatterjee Para.
7. Ashu Bose lane & Belilious Road X-ing towards Bantra PS.
8. Musalman-para lane & Belilious Road X-ing towards Bantra PS.
9. From Abani Dutta Road and Dobson Road X-ing towards Pilkhana X-ing.
10. M.S.P.C. Lane & Belilious Road X-ing towards Tikiapara.
11. Bata More towards Belilious Road.
12. From Bataitala towards Kazipara.
13. From Andul Road towards Carry Road on Kona Expressway and vice-versa.
14. From Andul Road & College Ghat X-ing towards Andul Road.

15. From Amtala TOP towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
16. At Banstala Ghat X-ing towards Kazipara.
17. At Telkol Ghat X-ing on Grand Foreshore Road.
18. From Santa Singh More towards Shalimar Road via Bharpara Road.
19. From Kazipara towards Foreshore Road and GT Road.
20. From Bankim Setu towards DM Slope and Foreshore Road.
21. From Fire Service Station towards Harimohan Bose Road and Fansitala.

Statement of Major and Minor punishment for the period from the period 16.06.2019 to 30.06.2019.

MAJOR PUNISHMENT
