ORDER

WHEREAS information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbance of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area mentioned in the schedule below (of the Shibpur Police Station) in the town of Howrah (hereinafter referred to as the said areas)

And

WHEREAS I Tanmay Ray Chaudhuri, Commissioner of Police, Howrah being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department Order No.-3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.11 to act under the Section 144 of the said Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974)

And

WHEREAS in my opinion, there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

And

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act. 2 of 1974) read with the sub-section (3) of the said section, I, Tanmay Ray Chaudhuri, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, do hereby prohibit for the period of 60 (sixty) days from the 5th February, 2019 to 5th April, 2019 until further orders, any assembly of 05 (five) or more persons in procession or the carrying of any lathi or other dangerous weapons or the doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances to the public tranquility and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

The Schedule

The area within the jurisdiction of Shibpur Police Station in the town of Howrah bounded –

- 1) On the North by - Haradeb Bhattacharyay Road upto and including Mandirtala Bus Stand.
- 2) On the East by - Khetro Banerjee Road, Nabin Banerjee Lane, A K Roy Chowdhury Lane and Mollapara Lane upto G T Road crossing including Kazipara Morh.
Hiralal Banerjee Road, Dinu Master Lane, Mollahpara Lane, Danesh Mollah Lane upto G T Road crossing.
- 3) On the West by - K M Banerjee Road, Circular 2nd Bye Lane, Seikhpara, Kona Expressway upto Carry Road crossing.
K M Banerjee Lane, Sarat Chatterjee Road upto old 58 Bus stand.
- 4) On the South by - Tarapada Chatterjee Road upto and including Betaitala Morh.

5) All the ramps of Vidyasagar Setu on Howrah side.

Explanation - In this order, the Town of Howrah means the town of Howrah as defined in Section 2(15) and Schedule - I of the Howrah Municipal Corporation Act, 1980 (Act of 29 of 1980).

ORDER

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places, network service providers and shops have come up in the Metropolitan area of Howrah as notified in this behalf, in the popular name Cyber Cafe,

AND WHEREAS, a large number of people frequently visit these Cafes to use the internet, computer network facilities available in those cyber cafes,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood that the said facilities might be used by persons knowingly or intentionally to mislead the security and investigating agencies, commit offence as defined in Chapter-XI of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), create panic in the public, help in anti-national activities affecting security of the state,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (l) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973(2 of 1974), I, Tanmay Ray Chaudhuri, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order, the owners of the said cyber cafes and persons having management of those cyber cafes to follow the followings in respect of those cyber cafes, viz. :-

- a) Prohibiting the use of cyber cafe by unknown person and whose identity has not been established before the owner of the cafe.
- b) Maintaining a register for identity of the visitors or users.
- c) Make an entry in the handwriting of the visitors or users maintaining name, address, telephone number and identity proof. The visitors/users shall also sign the register kept for this purpose
- d) The identity of the visitors or users shall be established through Identity Card, Voter Card, Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and Photo Credit Card (any one of them).
- e) Activity server log should be preserved in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months from the point of last use.
- f) If any activity of any visitors or users is of a suspicious nature, the owner of Cyber Cafe shall immediately inform the nearest Police Station.
- g) Record be maintained about the specific computer used by the visitor or user.

This order shall come into force on and from **8th day of February, 2019** and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto **8th day of April, 2019** unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order, is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through press and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of all Divisional D.Cs.P, A.D.C.Ps, A.Cs.P and all Police Stations concerned;

Schedule – I

ORDER

WHEREAS, from the reports received so far, there is sufficient ground to apprehend that the terrorists or anti-social elements may seek hideouts in the residential areas of the Police Stations, falling under metropolitan area of Howrah,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property on that account,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt necessary that some procedural safeguards should be put on tenancy or licensing process prevailing, so that terrorists or anti-social elements in the guise of tenants may not get tenancy or license for residential purpose and to cause disturbance or public tranquility or danger to human life or safety to public at large,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (l) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), I, Tanmay Ray Chaudhuri, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order that no land-lord or owner or person whose property falls under the jurisdiction of area of any of the Police Stations under Howrah Metropolitan area shall let/sublet/lease/rent out any residential accommodation or grant lease or license to any person unless and until the said landlord/owner/person has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s)/ license as the case may be as per the Proforma in Schedule-I to the Officer -in-Charge of the Police Station concerned. And whoever having property in his possession or under his management shall also inform in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premise falls about the particulars of the tenants or leasee or licensee as the case may be as per the said proforma.

This order shall come into force on and from **8th day of February, 2019** and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto **8th day of April, 2019** unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through Howrah Police Gazette, Official Website of Howrah City Police and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of DCP, Zone-I, DCP, Zone-II, ADCP (South Division), Divisional ACPs and all Police Stations concerned and the Offices of Howrah Municipal.

Whereas for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with the programme mass rally/meeting at Brigade parade Ground by West Bengal State Committee of Left Front in Kolkata on 03.02.2019, it is necessary in the interest of Public safety, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate area. Restriction for Goods Vehicles :

1. Nimtala crossing towards Bally along GT Road.
2. Ballykhal Island towards Bally along GT Road.
3. Bamundanga Island towards Bally & Dakshineswar along GT Road & Vivekananda Setu.
4. Near Salap More towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road on Kabardanga more.
5. Kona more on NH 6 towards Liluah along Benaras Road towards Jagadish Pur.
6. Kazipara Crossing towards Kolkata & towards Howrah via 2nd Hooghly Bridge and GT Road.
7. Coal depot towards Howrah along Foreshore Road.
8. Near Alampur More towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
9. Hung Sung Crossing towards Drainage Canal Road and 2nd Hooghly Bridge.

In addition to the above, no good vehicle will ply with in this Commissionerate area from 03:30 hrs to 20:00 hrs.

Restrictions for all other vehicles:

All Panchantala bound passenger vehicles will be diverted from Sarat Statue at GR Road towards Fish Market via IC Bose Road, CM Bridge, GT Road, Phansitala, Panchantala at Howrah.

Whereas, in view of urgent repair work half portion of Santragachi Railway Over Bridge will be closed for four days from 08.02.2019 to 11.02.2019 by NH Division-I, Public Work Department, Govt. of West Bengal, it is necessary to regulate traffic in the jurisdiction of Howrah Police Commissionerate to streamline traffic flow,

And whereas, it is necessary to prevent accidents and loss of life and property and to ensure safety and security of general public,

And whereas, it is essential for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with repair work of Santragachi Railway Over Bridge on Kona Expressway, It is necessary in the interest of Public safety, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Police Commissionerate area. I, Dr. Tanmay Ray Chaudhuri, Commissioner of Police, Howrah, in exercise of power conferred upon me u/s 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide Notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department, Govt. of West Bengal in suppression of all order/orders passed in this regard do hereby issued following restrictive orders as per following time schedule on the following roads:-

Date & Time

On 08.02.2019 at 08:00 hrs. to 11.02.2019 at 20:00 hrs.

Restrictions of Goods Vehicles

1. No goods vehicles will be allowed to ply through Kona Expressway, Santragachi Bridge from 08.02.2019 at 08:00 hrs. to 11.02.2019 at 20:00 hrs.
2. Kolkata bound goods vehicles (except high loaded containers) coming from NH- 2 and NH-6 will be allowed to take Howrah-Amta Road & G.T Road every night from 22:00 hrs. to 07:00 hrs. next morning on those days.
3. No goods vehicles to allow entering from Alampur towards Andul Road.
4. All port bound goods vehicles will enter into/exit from Kolkata between 22:00 hrs. to 07:00 hrs.
5. No goods vehicles will be allowed to enter from Kona More towards Benaras Road.
6. All relaxation to goods vehicles given in HPC area will remain suspended till Santragachi ROB repair work is going on.

Diversion of Goods vehicles

1. All goods vehicles coming from Kolakata side towards Kona Expressway will be diverted from 2nd Hooghly Bridge Toll towards Alampur/NH-6/NH-2 via Andul road.
2. All types of small & medium goods vehicles will be diverted from different points through Andul Road & Howrah-Amta Road for 24 hrs. on those days.

3. All port bound High loaded Container / goods vehicles will be diverted from Nibra More, Salap Crossing, Kona Crossing, Maitypara crossing to take entry towards Kolkata City / exit from Kolkata City through Nivedita Setu for those days.
4. All goods vehicles entering into Howrah Police Commissionerate area will be diverted from Nimtala- Belur Bazar more-Bandaghat from 22:00 hrs. To 07:00 hrs.
5. All goods vehicles of Howrah Police Commissionerate area going to National Highway will be diverted from Bandhaghat-Salkia- Benaras Road-Kona More from 22:00 hrs. to 07:00 hrs.
6. All small / medium goods vehicles going to Kolkata may will be diverted from different points Nimtala-Belur Bazar More – Bandaghat – Salkia School Road- Foreshore Road- 2nd Hooghly Bridge Toll from 22:00 hrs. to 07:00 hrs.
7. All goods vehicles (except high loaded containers) going to Kolkata will be divert from Alampur- Nibra – Salap crossing, Kona Crossing - CCR Bridge, Maitypara crossing -Nivedita Setu from 22:00 hrs. to 07:00 hrs.
8. During the time of closure of the bridge, small vehicles will be diverting Howrah-Amta Road/ Andul Road/ GT Road for to and from movement from the city to NH-2/NH-6.


